Courses not completed at their conclusion for reason approved by the administration will be recorded as "Incomplete". Such "Incompletes" must be removed the next quarter of attendance. If not completed within the year the Incomplete is recorded as a failure. Students who received an incomplete in any subject must make arrangements for make-up work with the instructor before the close of the third week of the next quarter.

A student who finds it necessary to leave school before the close of the session should make arrangements with the Deans for an honorable dismissal. If it is impossible to do this before leaving the student should write to the Deans as soon as possible explaining fully reasons for leaving.

A student program is a sixteen-hour program, exclusive of physical education or a one-hour course. No change in program can be made without the approval of the adviser. No credit can be allowed for work taken which does not appear on the program card which must be on file in the office of the Registrar.
