All men at the St. Cloud State Teachers College who have had their 21st birthday on or before October 16, 1940, are required to register on Wednesday, October 16 in accordance with the provisions of the selective service act. Provisions for registration at the college have been made. Students concerned with registration will watch the next bulletin for the special details.

Please reread regulations concerning absences due to illness in the Guidebook on page 11: "All absences due to illness are to be reported to the college nurse either by the student or by the householder on the FIRST day of absence. In case students wish to enter after unreported illnesses a blue slip will be issued from the office of the college nurse...The blue slips will inform the instructor that the nurse has no definite information that the student was actually ill....Other absences are to be reported to the instructor who will be responsible for admitting the student to class."
