GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Subjects to be dropped Subjects may be dropped only with the approval of the administration. Students who drop a course without permission will be dropped automatically from a second course and will receive a grade of "E" in each course. Students may drop a course during the first six weeks regardless of grade, but if he drops a course the last six weeks he will receive a grade of "E" if his work is failing at the time.
